Grease Recycling

You can recycle your used cooking fat, oil, and grease throughout the year. Simply collect your cooking oil and grease in a clean, dry container with a secure lid. Lids are important to avoid spills. Drop off your container at the City of Sierra Vista Compost Facility, located at 7201 E. Highway 90, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Contact Public Works at (520) 458-5775 for more information on grease recycling. Remember to recycle your used cooking oil and grease after Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day.



MyWaste App

Managing your household waste in the City of Sierra Vista just got easier! Download the MyWaste app and never lose track of your collection day with a pickup schedule customized for your location. MyWaste can remind you in advance of all holiday changes. Find the proper recycling/disposal procedure for hundreds of materials; learn the location, hours of operation and fee schedules for drop off depots and much more. Remember to Do Your Part—Recycle Smart!

Since 2011, Mountain Vista Communities has provided curbside recycling to residents through the City of Sierra Vista, offering weekly recycling pickups. One day per week the City will pick up your trash in the green bins, and the other day pick up recyclables in the blue bins. All you need to do is separate recyclables from your weekly trash and put them into your blue bin. Over 50% of everyday household trash can be recycled. It's easy and only takes a moment to separate recyclables from other waste.



Place Only These Items Into Your Blue Recycling Bin

Metal Cans: *Food and beverage cans only.*

Plastic #1 & #2 Containers: *Look for the #1 and #2 icons on the bottom of the container.*

Paper: *newspapers, magazines, office paper, junk mail, catalogs, phone books, and paper bags.*

Cardboard & Paperboard: *Includes: corrugated, cereal, shoe & food boxes, and paper towel and bath tissue roll core tubes. Remove all inside materials. Break down and flatten large boxes to make room for more recyclables.*

All items should be loose, dry, and clean.

When in doubt, leave it out!
