## Our Mission

Our mission is to invest in the interests of our high school aged youth. By taking on a mentorship role in the lives of these young people, Sierra Vista Fire & Medical Services hopes to encourage positive character growth while facilitating each cadet with the experiences of firefighting and emergency medical services. For those who remain interested, the gap between high school and Firefighter I & II, or EMT Basic college courses can be eased so students will have a better understanding of what lies ahead in those educational fields.

## Program Scope

This program encompasses the fields of emergency medical service and fire department roles in our community. Cadets will get hands on experience with firefighter protective gear, vehicle extrication, pulling hose and other fire related environments. They will be introduced to a variety of EMS techniques. Cadets are given the opportunity to earn a scholarship to be used for fire and EMS college courses through a written application process.

## Schedule & Attendance

Classes meet for five days, Monday through Friday from 0900 to 1400. Lunch and refreshments will be provided. Attendance is mandatory. Given the amount of material and the time frame involved punctuality, personal commitment, and participation are a must. There is no make-up time. Cadets who miss more than one class will be dismissed from the program.

### Who?

Youth ages 16 – 18 who are currently enrolled in a high school or GED program and are in good standing with a minimum 2.5 GPA.

### What?

A fire and EMS “academy” style program introducing area youth to the public services of fire and EMS.

June 5-10. Classes are held for five days, Monday through Friday from 0900 to 1400. All five classes must be attended. Lunch and refreshments provided. A graduation will be held on Saturday.

### Where?

City of Sierra Vista Fire Station 3.
