Passenger must display valid discount card.

SAFETY AND COURTESY RULES

After you have paid your fare, please move quickly to a seat. Note the seats marked for seniors or disabled passengers. Please make room for those passengers to board and sit comfortably. Free transfers are available at the Transit Center only. No eating, drinking, or smoking is allowed. Shirts and shoes are required. Service animals only. No fighting, pushing, throwing of objects, loud radios, or vulgar language. Do not talk to the driver when the vehicle is in motion. Strollers must be folded up when boarding the bus. Aisles are to be kept free of obstacles. Children age 12 and under must ride with an adult. Please pull cord before arriving at bus stop location.

Vista Transit has rules that govern behavior while using transit facilities. Vista Transit staff monitor and local police enforce these rules. Violators may be subject to arrest, fine, or exclusion from any or all vehicles and facilities.
