



## NOTICE OF CDBG FUNDING AVAILABILITY – PROGRAM YEAR 2021

The City of Sierra Vista, Arizona, is preparing its 2021 (July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022) Annual Action Plan (AAP) for submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The AAP serves as a planning tool and strategic document for the expending the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding. CDBG funding is required to benefit low- and moderate-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight, or address urgent need.

The purpose of the public meetings/hearing is to allow interested citizens, public agencies, community organizations, and other parties to share their opinions on housing and community development needs in the City and to propose projects for the City to consider funding with the CDBG. The **estimated** 2021 fiscal year funding is \$270,000. Generally, the City has accepted projects that comply with the adopted Five-Year Consolidated Plan. Such projects include Public Infrastructure/Facility Improvements, Housing Rehabilitation and Services, Provision of Needed Public Services, and Neighborhood Stabilization activities which are all CDBG eligible activities.

The City considers all information obtained at the meetings/hearing when choosing projects and preparing the Annual Action Plan. Anyone unable to attend the meetings or hearing may submit written comments to Matt McLachlan prior to **4:00 P.M., MARCH 5, 2021**.
